UNITED AIRLINES ADDS ADDITIONAL FLIGHTS FROM NORTHWEST FLORIDA BEACHES INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

United Celebrates Successful First Year with ECP, Increasing Service to Houston and Worldwide Connection Opportunities

PANAMA CITY, FL (March 23, 2016) – Northwest Florida Beaches International Airport (ECP) has announced that United Airlines will add additional flights from ECP to Houston, Texas, which provides easy access to their worldwide network.

United Airlines will offer passengers with increased air service offerings with an additional daily flight to Houston's George Bush Intercontinental Airport (IAH) beginning on June 9 during the month of June.

Preparing for more passengers, United Airlines will also increase its capacity by utilizing a larger plane during the weekends. By upgrading to an EMB 175, the passenger loads on this flight will increase from 50 to 75.

United Airlines celebrated one year of service in the region in March. ECP continues to grow and offer additional air service to passengers in the region. This announcement comes on the heels of a record-breaking year for ECP, with a total growth year over year of 9.35%.
