EMERGENCY ORDER 25-01  
POLAR PLUNGE**

**WHEREAS**, as of 12:00 p.m. CDT, on Monday January 20, 2025, the Florida Division of Emergency Management issued a Hard Freeze warning for Northwest Florida including Bay County and forecasts an extreme cold front (the "Polar Plunge") bringing dangerously cold temps & wind chills throughout North Florida; and

**WHEREAS**, the Florida Division of Emergency Management issued of a Winter Storm Watch on Monday January 20, 2025, covering the Florida Panhandle; and

**WHEREAS**, the Polar Plunge creates a significant risk of extreme cold temperatures, snowy and icy conditions, and icy roads around the Airport and in the neighboring areas in Bay County which requires postponing the Board's regularly schedule Board meeting.


