**<u>DEFINITION</u>**: Senior member of the airport maintenance team with knowledge in general maintenance as well as skilled work. Under general supervision this position is responsible for maintenance of the Terminal Building and out buildings, as well as working closely with department management to ensure a safe, efficient and passenger friendly airport. Performs related duties as required.

**EXAMPLES OF DUTIES**: Ensures that the Terminal Building and out buildings are maintained and repaired as necessary to meet the needs of the airport, its tenants and the traveling public. Coordinate and schedules with tenants to ensure that maintenance efforts have the least impact on their operation. Recommends purchases to department management based on established policy and procedure. Works independently, or with other maintenance team members, on basic to complex projects as assigned by department managers.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Graduation from an accredited high school or possession of an acceptable equivalency diploma. Five (5) years experience in general trade work in one or more of the building trades; licenses in plumbing, electrical and/or HVAC desireable. Knowledge of the principles, procedures and equipment used in the maintenance and repair of airport buildings and facilities. Must possess a valid Florida driver's license.

<u>MISCELLANEOUS REQUIREMENTS:</u> Must pass pre-employment drug testing as well as periodic testing in accordance with airport policy; must pass a 10-year, fingerprint-based, criminal history records check as required by the Transportation Security Administration. Position will require shift work to include evenings, weekends, and holidays, as needed.
