<u>TITLE</u>: Lightning Repair of Proprietary Airport Parking Control System Components at the Northwest Florida Beaches International Airport.

Commodity or Contractual Service Required:

The Airport owns and maintains a Parking Management and Control system located at the Northwest Florida Beaches International Airport. The system is "Operation Critical" as it supports airport public parking operations. Maintenance and technical support for this system is provided by contracted vendors who are manufacture-certified to perform the work.

<u>Performance and/or Design Requirements</u> (e.g. intended use, function or application, compatibility, requirements; reference to policy, rule, statute or other act of the Legislature, etc., as appropriate):

The proposed purchase is for repairs to mechanical and computer network components of the parking system damaged by a lightning strike on the Airport. Services include system diagnostics, computer/communication board repair and replacement, system reprogramming, and return to service testing. Replacement computer/software components must fully-integrate with existing system components that are not being replaced.

<u>Justification for single source acquisition</u> (what is necessary and unique about the product, service or source; steps taken to confirm unavailability of competition, as appropriate):

The existing TIBA brand parking management system provides for Ticket Issuance, Vehicle Tracking, Parking Access Control, Point of Sale, Sale Transactions, Networking, and Data collection at the Northwest Florida Beaches International Airport public parking facilities. Only partial component repairs and replacements are contemplated at this time thus requiring a specific/authorized TIBA Regional service provider.

Failure to file a written protest within seventy-two (72) hours shall constitute a waiver of any right to appeal this decision.
